George Lopez is a guy who has made lemonade from lemons at every turn. Since he became the plant manager at an L.A. airplane parts factory, George has handled a complicated and tumultuous job – including mergers, vandals and even a Presidential visit -- with his sense of humor intact.

George is further tested daily by the arrival of his newly divorced father-in-law, Vic (Emiliano Díez).
